#### **Overview**

This Border Regions Peer Exchange is a European Commission (DG REGIO) initiative that connects *b-solutions* cases with Interreg programme stakeholders facing similar cross-border obstacles. We are looking for 10 host organisations across Europe willing to share their experience — including challenges, partial solutions and remaining obstacles — with peers from other border regions.

As a selected host, you commit to: designing the visit agenda; making key stakeholders available during the visit; facilitating open discussion including on remaining challenges; submitting a structured visit report within two weeks after the visit; and optionally participating in up to two online follow-up meetings.

The programme provides methodological guidance, agenda preparation support, visitor coordination, facilitation materials, and a lump-sum compensation not exceeding €2,500 for organisational costs.

#### ***b-solutions* host organization cases do not need to be complete successes**

Cases at any stage of implementation are welcomed — including those where the solution is partially implemented, where obstacles remain, or where the approach has evolved since the initial *b-solutions* advice.
